~Only the nonprofits associated with the branch are eligible for voting in that branch. People voting online will be asked for their home zip code and will be presented with charities nominated by a nearby branch.

~This is a community-driven program. That's why we'll only be accepting votes from zip codes associated with the community.

~The voting process and the contest are open to residents of the U.S., at least 18 at the time of entry.
