Where is Your Upper Room?

When the disciples and the others gathered in that upper room after the death and resurrection of Jesus, what did they talk about? In the book of Acts, (1:14), it says that they were “constantly devoting themselves to prayer.” So, what did that look or sound like? I don’t think it means that they were silent, each one off to his or her own corner,

praying by themselves. I think that upper room gathering was a time of prayerful discussion with one another. It was a time when they acknowledged the presence of God in their midst, and that their conversations with each other were also prayerful conversations with God. It was prayer that was as devoted as much to listening as it was to speaking. Surely they were trying to work out with God, as they discussed with one another, what it was that had just happened to them and what it all meant. It was an important time which prepared them for the mission they were about to engage in.

When do we get to do that? When do you gather with others to prayerfully discuss what God is up to in your life? Who do you gather with regularly to discuss how God might be speaking to you through Scripture, addressing your life today? Where is your Upper Room? Mission is given life out of these discussions. Just as it was critical for the original disciples to be engaged in this type of prayer before engaging in the mission of Christ in the world, it is also critical for each of us.

How is Zion being led to enable more of this *Upper Room* prayer to occur? How is the Holy Spirit leading you to become a part of it? We all need to be in prayer regarding this vital aspect of our faith and mission.

Following the service, we will have a special coffee time in the Fellowship Hall. Mark your calendars and join us in worship, song and praise!

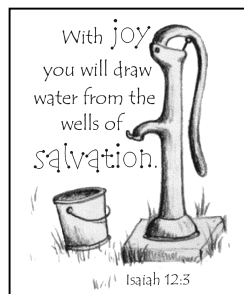

News from Our Financial Secretary

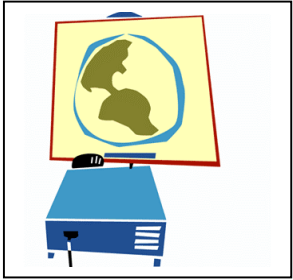
