

Indoor in-person worship: December 5, 2021

Indoor services will be held every other Sunday. Outdoor services will alternate with these indoor services. (If an outdoor service is cancelled because of weather, indoor worship will be available, first come, first served.) At this time, Zion is no longer requiring you to reserve a pew for the in-person indoor worship. <u>However, it is subject to change</u> and is dependent upon the positive test rate, cases per 100,000 and the probability rate. Social distancing practices will continue to be used (no passing of the peace or offering plate, limited & soft singing). Please visit Zion's website to read the <u>Protocols for In-Person Indoor Worship</u> - <u>all adults</u> <u>in attendance are required to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth</u> (the exception being Pastor who is leading worship). At this time, we acknowledge that there is some risk involved. Even though our local total population is 55.13% vaccinated which surpasses our safer goal of 50%; our 65+ age group is over our safe goal at 90.80%. The 18 & up vaccinated average is currently at 65.43%. We are also watching the test positivity rate. Our area's positivity rate is 11.45%, which is over our goal and persists above it. Cases per 100,000 remains high. Another measurement is a percentage of probability where, in a gathering of 50 people, how likely is it that someone with COVID-19 would be present. Right now, there is a 76.67% chance of this happening. <u>We feel that everyone's knowledge of the risk is important. We are publishing graphs in the weekly announcements that represent the **average numbers** of the following Counties: Oconto, Marinette and Menominee, MI. We are watching the trend of each graph with what are considered to be safer and safe goals in mind. The data used in the graphs is collected from the <u>CDC</u> website and from a website tool provided to us from our Northern Great Lakes Synod. Please make the time to familiarize yourself with the graphs/information. Should you have concerns, questions or comments, please do not hesitate to contact Zion's office.</u>

Our Savior's Seeks Donations


