### **Mobile Food Pantry**

The Marinette Salivation Army will host a Feeding America Mobile Food Pantry on July 21 at 10 a.m. A Mobile Food Pantry contains 15,000 pounds of food sent on a truck in order to provide food for 300 households in need, on a first come first serve basis.

The Mobile Pantry will be located at the Greater Marinette Menominee YMCA. The pantry will continue to be a drive-through process so they need people to unload the truck, direct traffic, load food into cars. Set up and volunteer check in will start at 8 a.m. with distribution beginning at 10. All new volunteers will be asked to sign a waiver. Masks are now optional, but those working with food will be required to
