Mobile Food Pantry

The Marinette Salivation Army will host a Feeding America Mobile Food Pantry on July 21 at 10 a.m. A Mobile Food Pantry contains 15,000 pounds of food sent on a truck in order to provide food for 300 households in need, on a first come first serve basis.

The Mobile Pantry will be located at the Greater Marinette Menominee YMCA.
