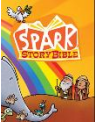

- TRASH BAGS for kitchen & bathroom
- TOILET PAPER
- DAWN DISH SOAP / Ajax cleaner / Window cleaner / Aluminum foil / Napkins
- ANTIBACTERIAL WIPES / Antibacterial sprays / Toilet bowl cleaner / Floor cleaner
- Zip-top bags: gallon, quart, sandwich / Zip-top freezer bags: gallon, quart
- LAUNDRY PODS / Dryer sheets
- Men's deodorant
- First aid kits / Band-Aids (variety of sizes) / Antibiotic ointment
- Approximately 20 closed bar soap containers (travel soap dishes) so each resident can keep their own soap

Items in ALL CAPITALS are most needed. Items underlined are specific brands or types. Residents are given a weekly allotment of certain items.
